Title	Recreation Cost Sharing Allocation to Canadian Forces Base (CFB) Edmonton
Proposed Motion(s)	That Council direct Administration to release the \$300,000 grant to the Canadian Forces Base (CFB) Edmonton as approved in the 2022 Operating Budget.
Administrative Recommendation	Administration recommends that Council support the proposed motion which also provides Sturgeon County residents access to an extensive range of recreational programs, services, and amenities at CFB Edmonton at a preferred rate.

	<u>November 12, 2019 Regular Council Meeting</u> Motion 441/19: That Council authorize a \$300,000 grant to the Canadian Forces Base (CFB) Edmonton, which will allow Sturgeon County residents access to preferred rate recreation amenities and programs at the Base.
Report	 Background Information Sturgeon County residents were provided access to the Edmonton Garrison Fitness Centre in 2021, to enjoy a myriad of programming opportunities and access to amenities at the same preferred rate enjoyed by members of the Garrison.
	• Despite the COVID-19 pandemic, Sturgeon County residents represent approximately 40% of program registrations at the Base. At the end of 2021, 731 County residents had memberships.
	• There were many examples of strong collaboration in 2021 and more planned for 2022, including the "Go Girl Event" aimed at supporting and inspiring young women to engage in recreation.
	• Sturgeon County residents continue to benefit from equal access to programs, reduced rates and memberships, and access to various

	recreational amenities at the Base, including, but not limited to, curling, golfing, and fitness.
	 <u>External Communication</u> CFB Edmonton will continue to promote and advertise their programs to Sturgeon County residents.
	• Corporate Communications will continue to promote utilization of the Garrison facility and associated amenities.
	 Copies of the Edmonton Garrison Community Guides detailing programs, services, and community events will be available to Sturgeon County residents.
	• With the releasing of COVID restrictions, Corporate Communications wi work with CFB Edmonton to enhance promotion of the programs and services available.
