Report	<p><u>Background Information</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Range Road 234 contract consists of grading, granular base course, asphalt concrete pavement, and other work on Range Road 234 from Township Road 560 to Highway 28. <p><u>External Communication</u></p> <p>Tendering</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Tenders for the Range Road 234 project were posted on Alberta Purchasing Connection (APC) on February 2, 2022 and closed on March 2, 2022. Twelve (12) bids were received, ranging from \$3,461,030 to \$4,784,799 excluding GST. Administration reviewed the tenders and recommends that Sturgeon County award the contract to E Construction, a Division of N.P.A Ltd., as they were the lowest compliant bidder. <p>Communications</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Following the contract award and prior to construction startup, notifications will be mailed to all affected residents.
