BYLAW 1417/20 ROAD CLOSURE BYLAW STURGEON COUNTY, MORINVILLE, ALBERTA

A BYLAW OF STURGEON COUNTY, ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSING TO PUBLIC TRAVEL AND CREATING TITLE TO PORTIONS OF A PUBLIC HIGHWAY

WHEREAS, section 22 of the *Municipal Government Act*, RSA 2000, c.M-26 and amendments thereto provides that a municipality may by bylaw close a road;

AND WHEREAS, the lands herein described are no longer required for public travel;

AND WHEREAS, application has been made to the Council of Sturgeon County (Council) to have a portion of a road closed;

AND WHEREAS, Council deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel certain roads, or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality, and thereafter disposing of same;

AND WHEREAS, notice of intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with section 606 of the *Municipal Government Act*;

AND WHEREAS, Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person claiming to be prejudicially affected by the bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of Sturgeon County, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. Sturgeon County does hereby close to public travel for the purpose of creating title to, the following described highways, subject to rights of access granted by other legislation:

Portion of Road, Subdivision Plan 802 0013 as shown on Schedule "A" Excepting thereout all mines and minerals.

- 2. This Bylaw shall come into force upon being passed.
- 3. If any portion of this Bylaw is declared invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the invalid portion is severed and the remainder of the Bylaw is deemed valid.
