 - 2 pumps with pressure tank and controls
 - Concrete Vault
 - ► Fill to Pumphouse

- Pipelines
 - Supply line from well site
 - Distribution lines
- Site locations
 - ► CC
 - Meter
 - Backflow preventer

Original Wastewater System

- Low pressure
- Each site has a septic tank
- Collection pipe system
- Evaporation Ponds

Current Systems

- Water System
 - Epcor water via pipeline from Rivière Qui Barre
 - Receiving Station in Community League parking lot
 - ▶ 36 connections
 - System monitored and maintained by Sturgeon County Utilities
- Wastewater System
 - Low-pressure
 - Septic tank at each site
 - Collection pipeline
 - Evaporation Ponds

Future

- Sturgeon County to take over the water and wastewater system
- Each family becomes a Sturgeon County Utility Customer
- Alcomdale Local Development Coop to complete accounting for the utility and stop providing water and wastewater services
