AMENDMENT TO PROCEDURE BYLAW 1301/13 STURGEON COUNTY, MORINVILLE, ALBERTA

A BYLAW OF STURGEON COUNTY, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO AMEND BYLAW 1301/13, THE PROCEDURE BYLAW TO REQUIRE MOTIONS AT COUNCIL BUDGET MEETINGS TO BE SECONDED

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 145(b) of the *Municipal Government Act*, a council may pass bylaws in relation to the procedures to be followed by council, council committees, and other bodies established by the council;

AND WHEREAS, Bylaw 1301/13, the Procedure Bylaw as amended, regulates the conduct of business in Council and Council Committee meetings;

AND WHEREAS, the Council of Sturgeon County deems it desirable to amend Bylaw 1301/13, the Procedure Bylaw, to promote meeting efficiency at Capital Committee and Council Budget Meetings;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to *Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised, 12th Edition,* seconding a motion means that the Councillor agrees that the motion should come before the assembly for consideration, and not that he or she necessarily favours the motion;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of Sturgeon County, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1.1. Bylaw 1301/13 is amended with the following additions:
 - 103.1 Motions made at Council or Committee meetings do not require a seconder unless sections 103.2 or 103.3 apply.
 - 103.2 Motions made at Capital Committee Meetings that recommend a financial commitment must be seconded.
 - 103.3 Motions made at Council Budget Meetings that make a financial commitment must be seconded.
- 1.2. If any portion of this Bylaw is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, then the invalid portion must be severed and the remainder of the Bylaw is deemed valid.
- 1.3. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon being passed.
