Report	 <u>Background Information</u> Annually, Council is required to designate one of the appointed Assessment Review Board (ARB) members as the Chair of the Local Assessment Review Board (LARB) and the Composite Assessment Review Board (CARB). It is the Chair's responsibility to convene panels of members according 		
	to the type of hearing. The Chair may delegate their responsibilities to another qualified board member.		
	 On August 8, 2022, Administration sent an email to all ARB members requesting that any member interested in becoming the Chair of the ARB to submit an expression of interest to the Clerk of the Board. D. (Lee) Danchuk provided his expression of interest, and it is attached for Council's review and consideration. 		
	• As the expression of interest contains Mr. Danchuk's personal information, it is provided in a private attachment and is withheld from disclosure in accordance with section 17 (disclosure harmful to personal privacy) of the <i>Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act</i> .
