Committee Direction **Background Information** Report The Agricultural Service Board (ASB) is a Council Committee that serves as an advisory body and assists Council in promoting, enhancing, and protecting viable and sustainable agriculture with a view to improving the economic viability of producers within the County. Canada's Agriculture Day is celebrated in February of each year and is a day dedicated to recognizing the contributions of those involved in the agricultural sector. The next Canada's Agriculture Day will be on February 15, 2023. At its December 2, 2022 meeting, the ASB discussed the opportunity that this day creates for conversations to be held about the importance of agriculture. It also creates an opportunity for educators to focus lessons around agriculture and food production.
