Request for Decision

Title 2023 Mid-Year Financial Report

Proposed Motion

That Council accept the 2023 Mid-Year Financial Report as information.

That Council approve a \$4 million transfer from 2023 taxation revenue to the General Operating Reserve to be used to offset unrealized revenue resulting from assessments reduced through the assessment complaint process.

Administrative Recommendation

Regular financial reporting helps to develop an understanding of the current financial circumstances, opportunities, and challenges. This information supports accountability and transparency, informs and supports decision making, and aids in the development of long-term and strategic plans. Administration is recommending that Council accept this report as information and authorize the transfer of \$4 million into the General Operating Reserve.
