Councillor Notice of Motion

Title	Documentation of Heritage Trails in Sturgeon County (Deputy Mayor Stang)
Purpose of Report	To provide information in response to Deputy Mayor Stang's Notice of Motion made at the February 13, 2024 Regular Council Meeting.
Proposed Motion(s)	That Council direct Administration to prepare a list of trails with historical significance on provincial and federal inventories within Sturgeon County.
Previous Council / Committee Direction	None.
Strategic Alignment	Council's Strategic Plan community outcome statement includes Thriving Communities: Engaging cultural, historic, and civic amenities.
Statutory Requirement Considerations	There are no statutory requirements for municipalities to review provincial and federal heritage surveys and registers for historic places.
Alignment to Levels of Service Delivery	Heritage conservation and preservation is not a level of service currently provided by Sturgeon County. Open Spaces is responsible for ensuring that capital projects and park plans comply with legislative requirements under the <i>Historical Resources Act</i> , which applies to all landowners in Alberta.
Anticipated Human Resource Requirements	Undertaking a review of provincial and federal heritage surveys, registers of historic places, and drafting the results in a report will require approximately six hours of staff time. This does not include any additional research and consultation with other stakeholders.
Anticipated Financial Resource Requirements	A review of provincial and federal heritage surveys does not require additional financial resources.
Additional Background Information	This scope of work will only include a search of designated or surveyed historic places under provincial and federal programs.
