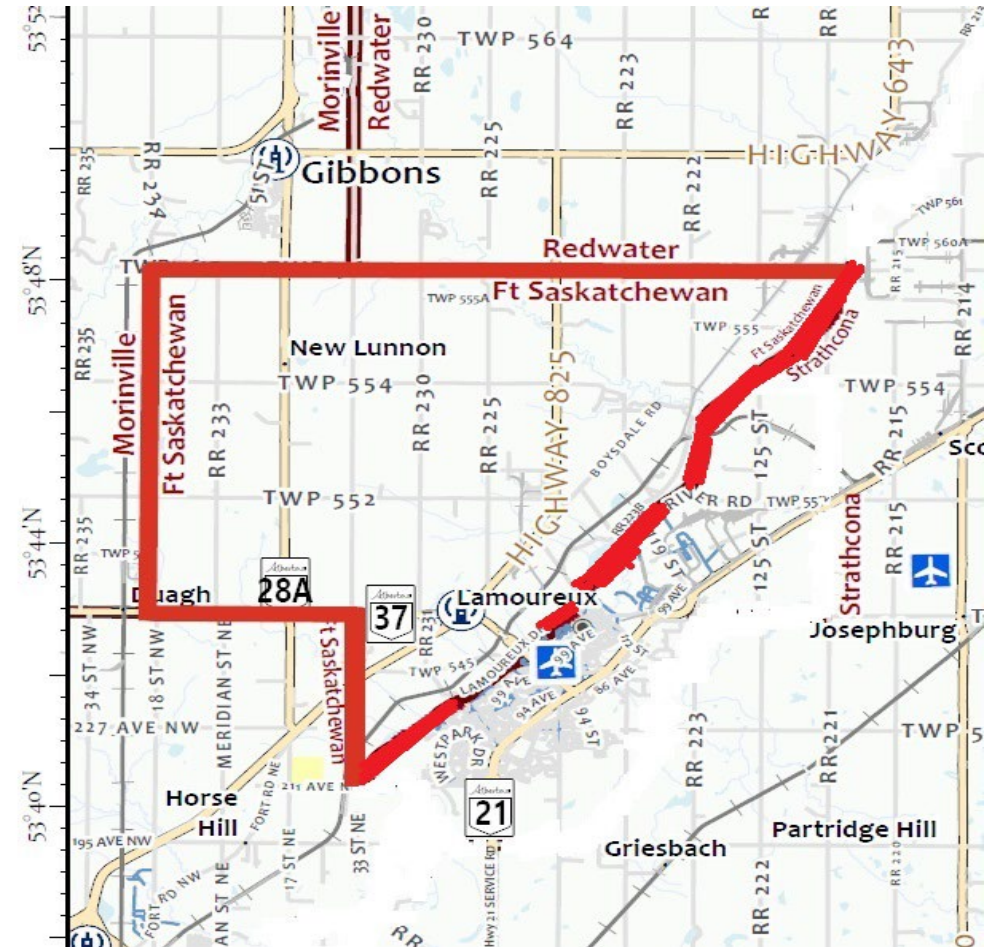

Jurisdiction

- The Fort Saskatchewan R.C.M.P. Detachment provides 24-hour policing services to the areas of:
 - Sturgeon Industrial Park
 - Lamoureux
 - New Lunnon



Call Volume

- Fort Saskatchewan Detachment provides policing services to 5% of Sturgeon County and responds to approximately 14% of all Sturgeon County rural calls for service. Sturgeon County makes up about 8% of the total Fort Saskatchewan Detachment call volume and 28.5% of total calls for service in our rural areas.
- In 2024, Fort Saskatchewan Detachment responded to 647 calls for service in Sturgeon County, including traffic enforcement.
 - 153 calls for service in Q3 (Oct - Dec 2024)
 - 78 2025 YTD (Feb 20)

Human Resources

- The Fort Saskatchewan R.C.M.P. Detachment is comprised of 41 Regular Members, and 24 Civilian Support Staff. Fort Saskatchewan Operations are also complemented by Fort Sask Area Victim Services, Restorative Justice and Commissionaire Guards.
- Current Provincial Resources:
 - Regular Members: 6 of 8 Provincial Members currently working
 - 1 medical leave, 1 hard vacancy
 - Public Service Staff: 2 of 2 working (1 temp covering 1 medical leave)

Files of Interest – (Q3) Reported

- Traffic Stop resulting in drug investigation, 1 oz of meth and cocaine located, two suspects arrested and vehicle towed.

- 3 Check-stops on Oct 5, Dec 6, Dec 7 (1 IRS Fail & 2 Caution)
- CSO breach of 37 year old Sturgeon County man as result of curfew check. Forged doctors note was produced in effort to obstruct investigators. Suspect remains in custody.
