---

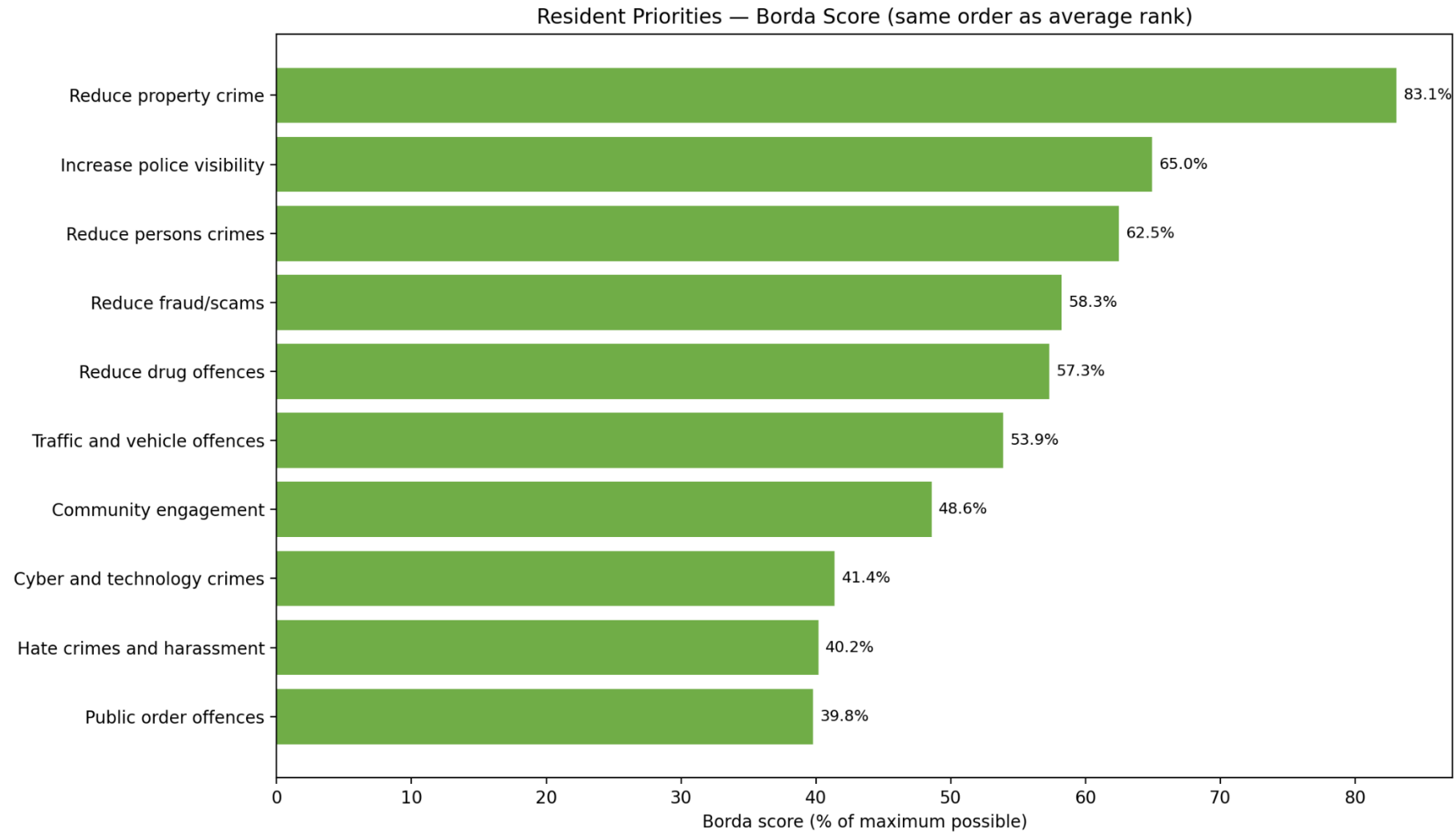
- This report provides a high-level overview of the feedback gathered during the community engagement process to help establish Sturgeon County RCMP community policing priorities for 2026.

# Engagement in Numbers

---

- Total Survey Responses – 149 responses collected
- Virtual Priority Meeting – 69 watched the live event (44 since)
- Website Views (Aug 2025 – Jan 2026) – 560 views
- Social Media Posts – Town Hall
  - Instagram – 1192 views
  - Facebook – 24,895 views
