Title | Sturgeon County Red Tape Reduction Update Issue The Province of Alberta requires municipalities to submit red tape reporting for 2021 by February 1, 2022. The attached presentation provides an overview of the County's efforts around red tape reduction for 2021 and identified projects for 2022. Report

Background Information

- The Government of Alberta has made red tape reduction a key initiative and tied funding for the Municipal Stimulus Program to municipal efforts to cut red tape.
- In 2021, Administration identified 22 projects as either red tape reduction initiatives as per the Province's definition or as efforts made by the County to streamline processes and improve service delivery.
- In 2022, 31 projects have been identified as part of red tape reduction initiatives or the County's efforts to streamline processes and improve service delivery.
- The attached presentation provides an overview of red tape initiatives completed in 2021 and planned for 2022. The presentation organizes the information into three broad themes:
 - 1. **Development Ready**: Infrastructure and land use plans are in place to provide investment certainty/shovel-ready opportunity.
 - 2. **Service Excellence**: Customers receive outstanding personal and professional service. Innovation is leveraged to improve service quality while ensuring cost-effectiveness.

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- 3. Competitive and Open Investment Climate: It is simple, costeffective, and timely to develop and invest or do business in Sturgeon County.
- Red tape reduction implies that government organizations are overly bureaucratic in their processes and approach to service delivery. "Winning" the battle against red tape may help create the initial impetus to review internal processes. Still, meaningful cultural change requires a deeper understanding of "why" and an invitation through example and inspiration to question "how we do things". As such, the County is taking steps to support the kind of thinking and action required to foster a culture of continuous improvement and innovation.

External Communication

Following the Committee of the Whole's review, Administration will submit a report in the prescribed format to the Province by February 1, 2022.
