
# Edmonton Global Hydrogen

# EXISTING AND PLANNED INFRASTRUCTURE

- Home of facilities that have made Canada one of top ten global producers of hydrogen today
- Existing Hydrogen Heartland Pipeline (Air Products) – Over 50 Km
- Home to the largest clean hydrogen production facilities in the world
- Existing large-scale CO<sub>2</sub> pipeline infrastructure
- New hydrogen and CCS infrastructure plans
  - Air Products' \$1.3 billion net zero hydrogen facility
  - Dow up to \$10B investment in net zero ethylene and derivatives complex
  - Imperial Oil Renewable Diesel, including use of low carbon hydrogen produced in region
  - Major clean hydrogen production projects planned by ATCO/Suncor, others pending
  - CCUS infrastructure proposals from Pembina/TransCanada, Shell, Oil Sands Producers
  - Projects to advance clean ammonia opportunities, led by Itochu/Petronas; Mitsubishi/Shell



# Leveraging our Assets to Create a Hydrogen Cluster




1. 'Piggy-back' on low-cost, low carbon industrial H<sub>2</sub> prod.





# Summit VISION
